

THANK YOU FOR YOUR PURCHASE OF THE VINTAGEVIEW® WINE RACK.

Model #'s WS-BIG1 and WS-BIG1-P

The VintageView® is simple to install using just a level, a wine bottle and a drill with phillips screwdriver bit. Follow the directions and diagram below to install your new wine racks.

Step 1:

Starting from either the left or right edge of the area to be racked, measure approximately 3 1/2" and place a mark for the centerline of the first rail.

Note: This measurement may vary depending on your bottle size. Therefore, it is recommended that the measurement be verified before mounting the first rail.

Note: Be sure to place the neck portion of the rack on the appropriate side to have the bottle necks point in the direction of your choice.

Step 2:

Determine the appropriate height above the floor and hold the rail in place while making adjustments to ensure it is plumb. Attach the first rail to the wall using appropriate fasteners for your wall surface. Please reference the chart below for our fastener recommendations.

Step 3:

Measure between 10" and 14" (depending on your bottle size) to the centerline of the next rail. Hold the next rail in place while making adjustments to the height and plumb of the rail and fasten it in place.

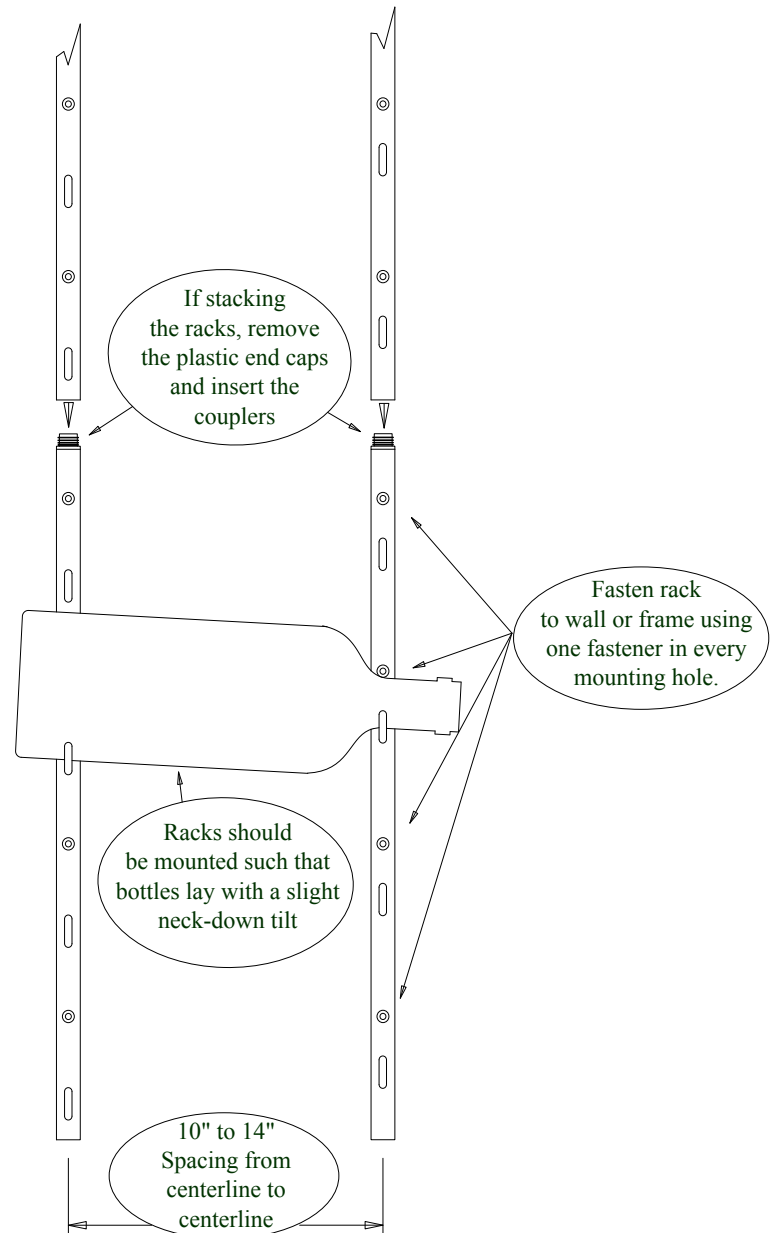
Note: As large format bottles vary greatly in shape, it is recommended that a bottle of similar size and shape be used to adjust the tilt of the bottle for personal taste.

Step 4

If mounting multiple racks side-by-side, measure approximately 7" (or just double the measurement from Step 1) over from the first rack and mark the hole location for either the neck or base side of your next rack. Follow the above steps for the balance of your mounting area.

Step 5 (Optional)

If stacking multiple racks one above the other, use the included coupler between upper and lower racks. Remove the plastic end caps from the top of the bottom rack and the bottom of the top rack and insert the coupler.



FASTENERS

There are eight pre-drilled mounting holes for fasteners on each set of racks, four holes per side - neck and base. It is strongly recommended that all eight mounting holes are utilized. The top fastener has the most pull out force (horizontal pressure away from the wall). When installing wall strips ALWAYS make sure the top fastener is solid.

We do not include fasteners with your racks because we never know what surfaces the racks will be attached to. However, we recommend the following fasteners:

Wood Surface: #8 x 1-1/4" wood screw

Drywall/Wallboard Surface*: #8 x 1-1/4" screw with spiral inserts for the bottom 3 mounting holes and an expanding wall anchor for the top mounting hole

Concrete, Brick Surface or Stucco: 3/16" x 1 3/4" masonry screw or expanding concrete anchor
