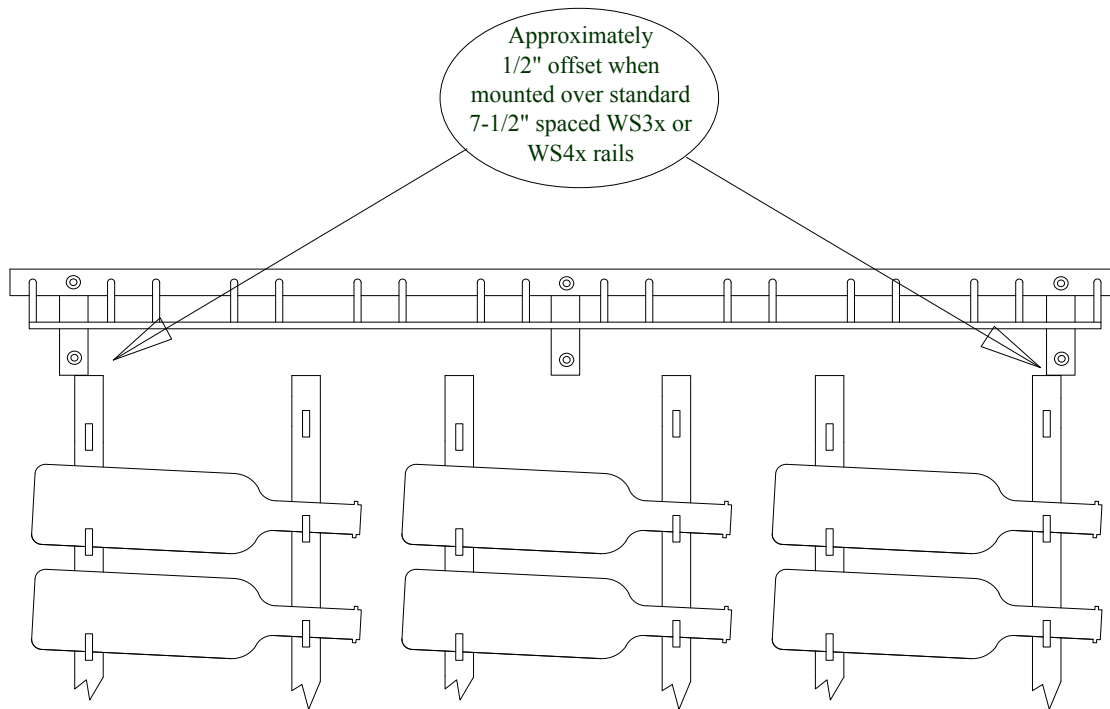


# THANK YOU FOR YOUR PURCHASE OF THE VINTAGEVIEW® WINE RACK.

□ □ Model #'s WS-PR and WS-PR-P

The VintageView® is simple to install using just a level and a drill with a Phillips screwdriver bit. Follow the directions and diagram below to install your new wine rack.



## Preparation:

If mounting the VintageView® WS-PR series rack above WS3x or WS4x racks, it is strongly recommended that those racks be mounted first following the provided instructions.

Gather the appropriate fasteners for your wall surface and the following tools:

Screw gun or screw driver  
Level  
Tape Measure

## Step 1:

Measure the desired distance above the floor and away from walls and mark the spot.

Note: If mounting above WS3x or WS4x series racks set for standard 750mL bottles, the legs of the WS-PR should be offset approximately 1/2" from the top of the base and neck rails as illustrated above.

## Step 2:

Hold the WS-PR in position and level the rack using a level

## Step 3:

Fasten the rack to the wall with appropriate fasteners. Refer to the table below for recommendations.

## FASTENERS

There are six pre-drilled mounting holes for fasteners on each WS-PR series rack. It is strongly recommended that appropriate fasteners be used in every mounting hole.

We do not include fasteners with your racks because we never know what surfaces the racks will be attached to. However, we recommend the following fasteners:

Wood Surface: #8 x 1-1/4" wood screw

Drywall/Wallboard Surface: #8 x 1-1/4" screw with spiral inserts and/or expanding hollow wall anchors such as toggle bolts

Concrete, Brick or Stucco: 3/16" x 1 3/4" masonry screw or expanding anchor
